PUBLIC TRANSPORT: Bus & TRAIN (i.e., Amtrak): I will be traveling to and from Camp via public train transportation. Travel fees will be \$30, one way. Round trip (pickup and drop-off) will be a total of \$60.00.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are allowed. Campers are prohibited from having alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs within**

their possession or consumed while on camp premises or during any off-campus trips. Any camper found in violation of this regulation will be sent home immediately.

2. Medications:

- a) Campers who are diabetic are required to bring all diabetic supplies (Meter, Strips, Lancets and Needles). Sharps container will be provided for each camper, as needed. NEVER dispose needles into camp trash cans. Disposing of needles is a safety concern for camp staff.**
- b) Camp Dogwood does not furnish CPAP machines and accessories or oxygen.**
- c) Camp Dogwood does not sensor, pump supplies, or provide CGM supplies.**

3. NO ELECTRICAL KITCHEN APPLIANCES are allowed in the dorms.

This includes lounges and porches. This includes, but not limited to, coffee pots, electric kettles, crockpots, etc. Camp Dogwood's insurance policy prohibits this.

4. Any camper who refuses medical treatment deemed necessary by the nurse and/or the camp administrator will have to leave camp once transportation is arranged.

5. Regardless of swimming capabilities, life jackets are required while campers are swimming.

6. Pets: No pets are allowed. Certified service animals are welcome. Owners are responsible for the behavior of their service animals and any damage caused by them. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their service animal. There is a dog run behind the Lineberger dorm. Owners are required to remain with their dogs while using the dog run.

No unattended dogs are allowed in the dog run. Dogs are not allowed on furniture. All dogs left alone in room must be tethered or kenneled. Please bathe your service animal the day before coming to camp and follow proper hygiene rules during camp.

- 7. Smoking Policy: Smoking is only allowed in a marked designated area. NO SMOKING allowed inside the dorms or rooms. If smoke is detected in your room due to smoking, YOU WILL BE CHARGED a \$200.00 Cleaning Fee.**
- 8. Weapons of any type are not permitted on campus, even with permit.**
- 9. All minor children, under the age of 18, must be accompanied by their parent or guardian at all times.**
- 10. If for any reason you are unable to attend your scheduled session of camp, please notify the camp office as soon as possible by calling 828-478-2135 extension 229. If no one is available to take your call, please leave a voicemail that includes your name and telephone number.**
- 11. ALL Campers, Caregivers, and Companions will be required to wear a name tag while in attendance.**
- 12. All applications must include a **color copy** of your identification card or other photo (See example photo on the last page of application).**
- 13. ALL CDC Guidelines that are current on the first day of Camp will be in affect the entire summer unless stricter guidelines are issued.**

14. Please advise our staff if you use any type of insect spray/repellent in your room. The sprays can harm the canine used for pest inspection.

15. Lost or removed items will be charged current market replacement price.

This includes but not limited to keys, remote, remote holder, pillows, and linens. Prices will be totaled and split among room occupants.

Quiet Hours

Campers must be at their assigned dorm by 10PM every night with noise levels at a minimum. *This does not mean that camper's must be in their rooms by 10PM, but they must be on the screened-in porch, in the common area, or in the rooms of their assigned dorm's.*

FAQ's

WHAT TIME DO I ARRIVE?

Please plan to arrive between 1:00pm and 3:00pm on Sunday, your first scheduled day. However, if this is not possible, please contact the camp administrator to make other arrangements as soon as possible.

Please note: The Camp Dogwood gates will not open until 1:00pm on Sunday.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I ARRIVE?

Make sure that ALL items, bags, and luggage are tagged with your name on it prior to arrival.

Registration will be in your assigned dormitory. The staff will not be available until registration time. No food is served until the evening meal at 5:00pm. However, the Camp Store will be open for purchase of snacks, starting at 2pm.

WHEN DO I LEAVE?

All Campers are REQUIRED TO CHECK-OUT BEFORE 10:00am ON THURSDAY.

WHAT DO I BRING TO CAMP?

- 1. Water shoes are highly recommended for all water activities, such as swimming and kayaking. The Camp Store will have limited water shoes available for purchase.**
- 2. Clothing: Bring enough clothes for seven days. There are no laundry facilities available for campers. Casual clothes are recommended. Be sure to bring socks for bowling, your swimsuit, water shoes, beach towels, and plenty of sunscreen if you intend to participate in outdoor and/or waterfront activities.**
- 3. Please bring any needed toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, razor, deodorant, feminine-hygiene-supplies, disposable underwear/pads [tampons, Kotex, Depends, etc.]). *Some items are for sale in the Camp Store.***

4. Money: You do not need to bring money unless:

b) You travel off-campus. You are responsible for money spent during off-campus trips. You may be required to purchase lunch if you're participating in off-campus trips. Most lunches will be \$10 or less.

➤ **Items in the Camp Store include: shirts, caps, bags, pens, and more. The store accepts: cash, checks, and credit/debit cards. Ice cream, drinks, and snacks are available every day with prices ranging from \$0.50 to \$2.00. Snow Cones are available every day for free.**

➤ **Please Note: There must be a \$10.00 minimum when purchasing items with a debit or credit card.**
